### City of Kuressaare

## **OUR HOST- SAAREMAA ISLAND**

Saaremaa is the largest island in Estonia, located in the Baltic Sea. Also known as the island of Vikings. It covers an area of approximately 2,673 square kilometers and features a diverse landscape that includes marshes, forests, limestone cliffs, and beautiful beaches. The island's unique geographical position contributes to its mild climate and rich biodiversity.





Saaremaa boasts a rich cultural heritage influenced by various historica! periods, including Viking age and Swedish and Russian rule. The island is home to numerous medieval stone churches, castles, and traditional villages that showcase Estonian architecture and craftsmanship. Notable sites include the Kuressaare Castle, one

of the best-preserved medieval castles in the Baltics, and the Angla Windmill Mount, which features iconic windmills representative of local agricultural history.

The islanders maintain a strong connection to their traditions through folk music, dance, and crafts. Saaremaa is famous for its unique folk costumes and handicrafts made from local materials. Saaremaa's culinary offerings are also noteworthy. The island has a growing reputation for high-quality local cuisine featuring fresh seafood and locally sourced ingredients.

## **HOW TO GET TO KURESSAARE**

AIRPORTS: There are 3 airports at your disposal. 2 are international

airports and 1 is local airport with the connection from

Tallinn.

Tallinn Airport 230 km/ 4:30 h (ferry time included)

Riga Airport 345 km/6 h (ferry time included)

Kuressaare local Airport 1,6 km- connection from

Tallinn airport

**BUS:** Tallinn Coach station- Kuressaare Coach station 230 km/

4:30 h (about 17 euros). Please note that the Tallinn Coach station is about 2,5 km from the Tallinn airport-

short walk or taxi ride away.
